**RFP2 (Issued: October 2004, Due: Dec. 7, 2004)**

**RFP2 Text:**

The Ann Campana Judge Foundation announces its second RFP with a proposal due date of December 7, 2004. For this funding cycle, each proposal will be limited to a maximum of \$4,000 from the ACJF. Projects supported during this funding cycle must have a start date no later than July 1, 2005 and an end date no later than December 31, 2006. Proposals that leverage funds or include in-kind contributions from other organizations/individuals are especially encouraged; such funds/contributions and their sources must be listed. The ACJF is currently placing a priority on those proposals dealing with water and sanitation projects in developing countries. Projects must be conducted in a developing country and involve the local population.

Please refer to Proposal Submission for complete information. Note that proposals not submitted in accord with the submission guidelines nor with all information requested will not be reviewed nor returned for revision. The ACJF is unable to “pre-review” a proposal to ensure that it is complete, but prospective proposers may contact the ACJF (email only) to see if a particular project is acceptable – send a one-page (maximum) single-spaced memorandum to [acjf@acjfoundation.org](mailto:acjf@acjfoundation.org). Note that the ACJF does not support scientific research.

Previous awardees who have not completed their projects or who have not submitted a final report are ineligible for this funding cycle. Awards will be made only to individuals or organizations based in the USA, Canada, Mexico, or Central America.
